President's Message

Dear Boca Zontians,

A taste of August history: Women's Equity Day is August 26th and is meant to commemorate the day when the 19th amendment was ratified in 1920 giving women the right to vote. The idea of equality between women and men was also fostered at that time. Women's suffrage was considered to have begun with the Seneca Falls, NY, convention held in 1848 to talk about the problem of women's rights. The group was predominantly women, but also included a few men. The group decided that American women were their own individuals, not just extensions of their husbands and fathers and should be afforded their own political identity. They drafted a "Declaration of Sentiments, Grievances, and Resolutions". Several women, including Elizabeth Cady Stanton and Susan B. Anthony were significant to the movement.

Today this holiday has grown to be so much more. It celebrates all the women's organizations country-wide continuing to work hard to provide women with equal opportunities in education, employment and pay, as well as celebrating progress made.

The 64th Zonta International Convention is history. It proved to be a very busy convention with interesting speakers and many bylaws amendments, as well as election and installation of officers for the 2018-2020 biennium. I appreciated the opportunity to serve as delegate for our club, as well as carrying the proxies for the Savannah and the Marathon clubs.

Recognizing that Zonta International celebrates its Centennial year in 2019, the 2020 convention will be held in Chicago, IL, at the Marriott Downtown Magnificent Mile. It will be a convention of celebration as well as business. Although Zonta was established in Buffalo, NY, there are no locations able to accommodate a convention of our size. Since Headquarters is now in Chicago, the decision was made to hold convention there.

Planning for our major fundraiser to be held January 26, 2019 is under way. Our first planning meeting will be held on Wednesday, August 22nd at TooJay's at 9:00 am. A notice and agenda will be sent out shortly. We are looking forward to another successful event.


