You can attend the 62^{nd} Zonta International Convention for just <u>ONE DAY</u>. If you can't be there all week, come for a day. The registration cost for a single day is \$150 so look at the schedule and see if there are specific

presentations you want to see. Find other Zontians who have booked a room and be the third in their room for a night. You can come and it doesn't have to cost you a lot of money. Of course, we'd really like you to come and volunteer some of your time as a member of the host District. We need tons of help with all sorts of projects—before, during and even after Convention.

DID YOU KNOW?

If you register for the full convention before May 18th you save \$50 or \$100. Full <u>registration is only \$399</u> if you register now, \$459 if you wait until after May 19th and \$499 if you wait until after June 14th.

DID YOU KNOW?

The cost to **register a guest is only \$100**. So, bring your spouse, your sister, a good friend or a potential member and see all the awesome activities, the wonderful costumes from around the world, attend one of the ethnic dinners, or even go on a tour around the Orlando area. Daily tours include the Kennedy Space Center, Farris & Foster Chocolate Factory, Art in the City, Winter Park Cultural Tour, and others. There are 2 dinner shows. too. DID YOU KNOW?

The World Center Marriott is the place to be June 27th to July 1st, 2014. The <u>rates are very reasonable—starting</u> <u>at \$169 per night</u> for a single or double, \$189 for a triple, and \$209 for a quad room. Rates are in effect from June 21st through July 7th. So come early or stay late and enjoy all that Orlando has to offer. Parking is an additional \$15 per day for self-parking and \$27 per day for valet parking.
