Dear Boca Zontians,

May is the time of year to reflect on our accomplishments for this past Zonta year and look forward to the new Zonta year 2019-2020, beginning June 1. Our annual meeting will be held on May 15 at which time we will induct new members and install officers. We will also provide an orientation for newer members and re-energize all of us in preparation for another active Zonta year.

What have we done this past year?? We continue to provide significant hands-on service to our community, while also raising funds for contributions to complete our commitment to ZIF and assist our recipients, Women's Circle and the Not Just Me Foundation. Further, we added to our scholarship funds.

We held a successful Membership event and gained several new members during this year and look forward to continued successful recruitment.

During our fundraising luncheon in January, in celebration of Amelia Earhart month, we were also able to recognize a local female pilot, Myra Bugbee, for her contributions in empowering women through her efforts in mentoring young women and influencing them to consider aviation as a viable career choice. Additionally, we enjoyed wonderful entertainment by the Rhythm Chicks and raised funds for our service projects and scholarship fund.

Our hands-on activities included:

- Several days of volunteering at Boca Helping Hands, while also making food donations to their food bank, including food for 13 Thanksgiving meals.
- 2. Participating in The Field of Hope Speakout at Palm Beach Victim Services, an event to support and advocate for survivors of sexual assault during which survivors are invited to write and place personal messages in the Field of Hope, as a symbol of reclaiming their power and provide hope to others. We provided food and volunteered that day to serve it.
- 3. Participating in the Women's Breast and Heart Health Initiative's outreach which involved going door-to-door in underserved neighborhoods to educate women in the area about the value and importance of breast and heart health, while also making them aware of the opportunity to access free mammograms and heart screenings in their own neighborhoods.
- 4. Holding a social event in December to collect Toys for Tots.

Additionally, we had a speaker from Habitat for Humanity to acquaint us with the mission and potential volunteer activities to consider in the near future. Further, we were able to award our Boca YWPA scholarship to a wonderfully talented young woman and hear about how active and committed she is.

While this is not new information to everyone, it is important to reflect on all those activities and recognize the difference and the contributions we have made in the lives of women in our community.




Palm Beach County Victim Services
