President's Message

Dear Boca Zontians,

November is a month full of Zonta activities including Zonta's 99th birthday, the International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women, and the beginning of the 16 Days of Activism against Gender-based Violence and the Zonta Says No to Violence Against Women Campaign.

November 8, 2018 Zonta celebrates its 99th birthday. Happy 99th Birthday, Zonta!! The first Zonta Club was founded in 1919 in Buffalo, NY under the leadership of Marion de Forest, whose vision was of an organization that would bring women in executive positions together and assist them in reaching their rightful places in the professions that rarely had women leaders. By 1923 clubs had been established in NY City, Washington D.C., Detroit, Cleveland, and Toledo, Ohio. On November 8, those first Zonta clubs met to organize the Confederation of Zonta Clubs. Since that time Zonta's members have dedicated their time and tirelessly worked to empower women.

November 25th is designated as the International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women. This designation was made by a resolution of the United Nations General Assembly in 1999. The premise of the day is to raise awareness that women around the world are subject to rape, domestic violence, and other forms of violence, as well as to highlight that the scale and true nature of the issue is often hidden. The date is based on the 1960 brutal assassination of the three Mirabal sisters, political activists, in the Dominican Republic. Governments, international organizations and NGO's are invited and encouraged to organize activities to raise public awareness of the issue on that day.

The 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence theme for 2018 is "End Gender-Based Violence in the World of Work". It begins on November 25, 2018, the International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women and runs through December 10, 2018, Human Rights Day. It is a time to galvanize action to end violence against women and girls around the world, as well as push for systemic change and accountability. During this time Zonta clubs and districts are encouraged to participate in the "Zonta Says No to Violence against Women" Campaign and take actions to influence making and implementing laws, as well as changing gender-based attitudes and behaviors to end violence against women. The 2018 Zonta Says No to Violence against Women Campaign will focus on child marriage, creating awareness of this harmful practice.

Also, during this month of November, we celebrate Thanksgiving. Have a wonderful day enjoying family, friends, and great food!!
