This November starts with the voting process which includes issues of awareness about fairness to women in the work force. International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women, and the beginning of the 16 Days of Activism against Gender-based Violence and the Zonta Says No to Violence Against Women Campaign.

On November 8th Zontians celebrate 101 years of work, knowledge, activism, and collective support of women worldwide. Lead by Marion de Forest, she and other like-minded female executives organized the Confederation of Zonta Clubs. Their vision was of an organization that would bring women in executive positions together and assist others in reaching their rightful places in professions that rarely had women leaders.

November 25th is International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women and the start of ZONTA's 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence campaign. During this time Zonta clubs and districts are encouraged to participate in the "Zonta Says NO to Violence Against Women" campaign and take actions to influence making and implementing laws, as well as changing gender-based attitudes and behaviors to end violence against women.

The International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women designation was made by a resolution of the United Nations General Assembly in 1999. The premise of the day is to raise awareness that women around the world are subject to rape, domestic violence, and other forms of violence, as well as to highlight that the scale and true nature of the issue is often hidden. The date is based on the 1960 brutal assassination of the three Mirabal sisters, political activists, in the Dominican Republic. Governments, international organizations, and NGO's are invited and encouraged to organize activities to raise public awareness of the issue on that day.

In our great U.S.A., we end the month with a celebration and welcome a future that holds thankfulness of our blessings and new alliances. Please help us support our local food bank, Boca Helping Hands, in its efforts to supply every family experiencing food insecurity with a nutritious Thanksgiving dinner. I wish you all a wonderful Thanksgiving day enjoying family, friends, and great food.


