October is the month we recognize the International Day of the Girl Child and United Nations Day. Since 2012, October 11 has marked the International Day of the Girl Child to highlight and address the needs, rights and challenges girls face around the world. UNICEF and partners realize it is essential to support and invest in girls by transforming the risks and deprivations they face into pathways to a better life. That includes such challenges as preventing and responding to gender-based violence. As well as advancing girls' secondary education.

United Nations Day is celebrated on October 24 and marks the anniversary of entry into force of the UN Charter in 1945 as an intergovernmental organization intent on creating cooperation between all the governments of the world. Originally it was intended to replace the league of nations, and prevent another war like World War II from occurring.
