Dear Boca Zontians.

October is the month when we recognize the International Day of the Girl and United Nations Day. Every year on October 11, the International Day of the Girl, UNICEF works with girls to amplify their voices and stand up for their rights. The theme for this year is GirlForce: Unscripted and Unstoppable. This year marks 25 years of progress for girls since the Beijing, China Fourth World Conference on women, where some 30,000 women and men from nearly 200 countries arrived determined to recognize the rights of women and girls as human rights. Under the theme, GirlForce: Unscripted and Unstoppable, we celebrate achievements by, with and for girls since the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action. Girls have moved from dreaming to achieving. More girls are attending and completing school, fewer are getting married or becoming mothers while still children themselves and more are gaining the skills they need to excel in the future world of work. Girls are breaking boundaries and barriers posed by Stereotypes and exclusion, including children with disabilities and those living in marginalized communities. As entrepreneurs, innovators, and initiators of global movements, girls are creating a world that is relevant for them and future generations.

United Nations Day is celebrated on October 24 which marks the anniversary of the 1945 UN Charter. While it is a day to reflect the 70 years, plus of history, struggle and accomplishment, it is also a day for taking note at what the UN is doing today to build a better world and how it plans to continue this well into the future.
