## **HUMAN TRAFFICKING OR CODE FACT SHEET**

#### WHAT:

The QR Code is a tool to enable victims of human trafficking to report their situation and know their rights. Preprinted codes are  $1.75'' \times 1.75''$  squares on vinyl coated paper that can be affixed to any surface. Because of the coating they are weather resistant and the print will not come off if exposed to rain or cleaning products.




#### **HOW YOU CAN HELP:**

Order the QR Code from Twentyfour-Seven.org and post it in every facility you own, operate, or can contact. (There is no charge for the code unless large amounts needed).

Contact public officials in your community, county, state and ask them to sign a contract for \$1.00 (one dollar) with Twentyfour-Seven.org to get the right to include the QR Code on documents they produce. (The \$1.00 fee is to protect the patent on the QR Code.)

Distribute the QR Code yourself in transit areas, convenience shops, laundromats, bodegas, pay day loan companies, medical offices — be creative — they can go anywhere and everywhere.
