TRAFFICKING IN PERSONS ON May 4, 2022

Trafficking in persons (also known as human trafficking) is commonly defined as the use of violence, deception, or coercion to transport, recruit or harbor people in order to exploit them for forced prostitution, forced labor, criminality, marriage, or organ removal. Perpetrators of human trafficking target the marginalized and the impoverished, entrapping victims, the majority of whom are women and girls, for sexual exploitation, forced labor, domestic service, and other forms of exploitation.


